- i. Bengali
- ii. English
- iii. History
- iv. Philosophy
- v. Political Science
- vi. Sanskrit
- vii. Sociology

NOTE: The candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/ 4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects (including one language subject) with at least 45% marks in aggregate or 50% marks in subjects or related subjects in the qualifying examination.

2. **B.A. (Multidisciplinary Programmes) in HUMANITIES:**

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Board/Council (list of the boards/councils are given) in the year (2021/2022/2023) are eligible to apply for General course with subjects

(i) *Bengali* (ii) *English/ Sociology* (iii) *History* (iv) *Philosophy* (v) *Political Science* (vi) *Sanskrit* provided. The candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/ 4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects (including one language subject).

N.B. Candidates who have passed vocational course can apply in MULTIDISCIPLINARY Course only.

3. **B.SC. (Multidisciplinary Programmes) in LIFE SCIENCE :**

Candidates passing Higher Secondary Examination conducted by West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other equivalent Board/Council (list of the boards/councils are given) in the year (2021/2022/2023) are eligible to apply for B Sc (MDC) course with subjects 1. *Zoology*, 2. *Physiology* and 3. *Botany*, provided the candidate must have passed in 5(Five)/ 4(Four) (where applicable) recognized subjects (including one language subject and Science subjects).
